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What is the EasyMark Service?

- EasyMark offers a marking and diagnostic reporting service for all commonly used tests including all of the PAT test series, NAPLAN past papers **(Please check with us on the year you are going to use)**, New Torch Reading Comprehension.

How does EasyMark work?

Schools complete their tests and post them to us including a copy of the Marking Order Form with schools details.

The results and the test papers are sent back to the school with an invoice for the marking. There is usually a one week to 10 day turn around for this process but please call us to talk about special deadlines.

All results are sent as excel spreadsheets and printable pdf files by email. Test papers will still be returned by Australia Post.

How does EasyMark charge?

EasyMark test papers are supplied by the exact number you require and are charged on a per paper basis. You will need a Teachers Instruction Manual for each year level of each test, but these can be reused in subsequent years. Or you purchase your tests elsewhere and just use the EasyMark marking and analysis service. **We have generic Answer Sheets suitable for most tests that we are happy to email to you.**

For most tests, marking costs are calculated by adding a base price of \$7.00 per group to the individual marking charge for a paper eg 24 students in a Yr 3/4 class doing EMTS Maths tests; 2 x \$7.00 plus 24 x \$2.50 = \$74 plus GST.

There is a postage and handling charge for all batches – price varies according to size of package and location of school. We use the Australia Post Parcel Post service.

English

EasyMark Language Conventions Tests (EMLC) Years 1-7

This test series has two forms for each year level and covers spelling (20 to 30 questions) and punctuation and grammar (20 to 30 questions). The format is similar to NAPLAN tests and electronic results provide strong diagnostic information linked to the Australian Curriculum.

Persuasive or Narrative Writing (NAPLAN Marking Guide) Years 2-10

The tests are marked by trained and experienced markers. Results are given for areas such as punctuation, grammar, spelling, genre, form etc. The results are expressed in scores and bands at the child, class and school level. Available in Persuasive and Narrative for all years. The latest marking rubrics are adopted as soon as normed information is available. Schools should set their own topic and use the same guidelines and timing as NAPLAN. Use lined paper, make sure first name and last names are on the top as well as gender. DO NOT INCLUDE PLANNING.

PATR– Reading Comprehension (Yr1-10, Vocabulary Yr3-10 or Spelling Yr 2-10) Fourth EDITION

Traditional test of vocabulary, comprehension and spelling lists. Results in the form of percentiles, stanines and graphs are provided at the student, class and school level.

TORCH (3rd Edition) Reading Comprehension Years 3 - 10

TORCH is a modified cloze procedure test with 14 sub-tests. Diagnostic information is provided about each child and class and a whole school profile is provided.

Student Outcome Reading Years 1-7

This test has comprehension items addressing relevant Outcome Statements in the Reading Strand for children of each year level. Standardised scores are available.

Student Outcome Spelling Years 1-7

This test has 5 parts including a dictation passage. Students are asked to identify errors and to supply the correct spelling in sentences and passages. Discriminates well at upper levels. Standardised scores are available.

Student Outcome Mathematics Tests

NAPLAN Marking

NAPLAN – full marking and analysis service

Student Self Esteem Years 2 - 12

A 40 item self-assessment inventory which gathers information about students' ability to make friends, secure, self-confidence, self acceptance etc. Normed scores identify children at risk. Class and school profiles are provided.

Attitude to School Subjects Years 2 - 7

A short instrument which asks students about their opinions regarding the importance of 12 subject areas, and whether they feel able to handle the work they are doing in those areas. The test results in a profile of student attitude across the subject areas. More detailed information about specific subjects can be obtained from the separate subject instruments listed.

Attitude to Library Years 3 - 10

Students' opinions regarding their use and enjoyment of the library, and their assessment of their ability to use it to find resources for study and pleasure.

Attitude to Reading Years 3 - 7

A self-assessment inventory which asks students about such aspects as enjoyment of reading, books available at home, use of local library, ability to handle set reading tasks.

Attitude to Science Years 6 - 12

40 item inventories asking students about their interest in, enjoyment of, ability to handle, and the perceived value of science.

EasyMark Attitude to Mathematics Years 3 - 7

A 24 item self-assessment inventory which asks students about such aspects as enjoyment of mathematics, their ability to handle the work and their assessment of the importance of mathematics.

Years 8 - 12

A 40 item self-assessment inventory which asks students about such aspects as enjoyment of mathematics, their ability to handle the work and their assessment of the importance of mathematics.

This inventory asks students about their Learning skills (such as note-taking and summarising), access to resources for homework and study (such as references), goal-setting, and exam skills. Results for each student and class are provided in comparison with State norms. Information is provided about each student both globally and regarding each item. A Whole School profile is provided.

Attitude to School (24 Item) Yr 2-7

A questionnaire gathering information about students' enjoyment of school, interest in the subjects, value of education, parent attitude to education etc. Normed comparative data are included.

Attitude to School (60 Item) Years 6-12

A questionnaire gathering information about students' enjoyment of school, interest in the subjects, value of education, parent attitude to education etc. Normed comparative data are included.

Attitude to Bullying (60 Item) Years 6-12

A version of the Attitude to School instrument, asks about the frequency and severity of bullying at the school, who is bullied and what is done about bullying.

A 40 item questionnaire for staff, addressing aspects of leadership. Communication, innovativeness, decision making.
